MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Byford & Districts Country Club (BDCC) Member's Code of Conduct applied equally to members and their guests, including players from other clubs visiting the BDCC for sporting competitions and social functions.

Members of the Byford & Districts Country Club Inc. have the responsibility to:

1. Assist in fostering a family-friendly, all-inclusive club atmosphere at the BDCC.
2. Abide by and uphold the BDCC Constitution, Dress Code Policy and this Code of Conduct.
3. Treat other BDCC members, their guests and BDCC employees fairly, equally and with respect.
4. Follow any reasonable direction or requirement given by a member of the BDCC Board of Management, Operational Management Team, Front-Line Employee, any BDCC paid contractor or any other authorised member of the club.
5. Always behave responsibly and appropriately. This use of foul and/or obscene language is not permitted.
6. Not engage in any behaviour, practice or activity that would likely cause damage to the harmony and reputation of the club and its members, either within the club or outside in the community.
7. Where using any of our sporting facilities; conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner and not knowingly cheat, damage equipment, disrespect other members, official and/or fellow competitors.
8. Not engage in any behaviour, practice or actions that is likely to cause damage or destroy property owned by the club, other club members and/or their guests.
9. Not engage in making any defamatory comments on social media pages.
10. Abide by all federal, state and local laws, by-laws and/or regulations.
11. Always supervise and monitor the behaviour of your guests.

Members who contravene any provisions set out in this Code of Conduct or Constitution may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the BDCC Constitution. Members may face disciplinary action for the actions and/or behaviour of their guests whilst on club premises.
